### Module Learning Aims:

This module will offer an overview of key moments and debates in 20<sup>th</sup> century Anglophone/Analytic Philosophy (and its German and Viennese roots).

### Module Learning Outcomes:

Students will become familiar with the work of key figures such as Frege, Russell, Stebbing, Wittgenstein, Quine and Kripke.

### Module Content:

Topics covered may include: Frege's analysis of quantification and the foundations of arithmetic, sense and reference, Russell's theory of descriptions, Stebbing and Moore on philosophical analysis, Carnap and Ayer's rejection of metaphysics, Quine on ontology, Kripke on necessity and essentialism.

### Assessment:
