Module Outline:

The aim of the seminar is to work together on a new project on Plato, Foucault and Hadot on the care for the self. The seminar will combine:

- Reading Plato from this angle (the care for the self): especially Plato's *Phaedo*, the *Apology*, and *The Seventh Letter* and *Alcibiades I*.
- Reading some papers-in-progress of mine on these three works from this angle (the care for the self).
- Reading some very interesting work by Michel Foucault and Pierre Hadot on the care for the self in Greek philosophy and Plato. Also, the more recent work by John M. Cooper.
