

Doctorate in Clinical Psychology (D. Clin. Psych.)

We are pleased to invite applications for the Doctorate in Clinical Psychology in Trinity College Dublin, a three-year full-time professional training course in clinical psychology run in partnership with the Health Service Executive. **Applications are open from 1st November.** The course is currently accredited by the Psychological Society of Ireland (PSI). A limited number of places are available for the 2026-2029 course.

Currently postgraduate students on this course are employed by the Health Service Executive on the Trainee Psychologist salary scale and in addition have a contribution towards fees paid on their behalf. This funding is not available to those wishing to upgrade their existing training/qualification in clinical psychology. The course does not accept self-funded applications. Graduates of the course will undertake to work in the Irish health services for a three-year period following completion of the course.

Candidates must have twelve months (1820 hours) full-time or equivalent postgraduate experience achieved in the last 5 years, within health or related setting (includes voluntary experience and excludes research). This contact must involve direct contact and provision of care to individuals who comprise the population associated with using clinical psychology services. Experience via online web support or telephone support services may be considered as contributing to the required hours up to a maximum of 25% of the total experience. At least 50% of clinical experience must be gained in a psychology assistant post involving regular supervision by a qualified psychologist employed in the same organisation. The remaining 50% of the experience must have been gained in a public service health or social care setting. Clinical experience must be gained subsequent to the completion of the qualification that confers eligibility for graduate membership of the Psychological Society of Ireland and within the five years immediately prior to the closing date for applications.

Experience gained in a research capacity is not counted as clinical experience.

Placements are currently based across Dublin, Wicklow and Kildare regions.

The application fee is non-refundable, and candidates are advised to make themselves available on the notified date for assessment. Inability to attend the assessment on the designated date will not constitute grounds for a refund of the application fee.
