

Mentor Trainer

Role Description



An S2S Mentor Trainer is a paid student role responsible for delivering Mentor Training sessions, in partnership with another Trainer, to newly recruited Mentors for the upcoming academic year. Mentor Trainers must have previously served as an S2S Mentor and will draw on this experience to provide realistic insights and expectations during training.

Requirements

- Have completed at least one full year as an S2S Mentor with active engagement and logged Odyssey activity.
- Be available to deliver training between February and May. S2S will run 40 4-hour sessions during this period; you must be able to deliver on average one session per week.
- Attend a short (15-minute) interview.
- Attend one in-person, 4-hour Trainer training.
- Hold a valid PPS number and a work permit (where applicable).

Benefits

- Full training (one in-person, 4-hour session).
- Payment of €14 per hour.
- Valuable experience in leadership, teamwork, and facilitation.
- Guaranteed references based on logged activity and involvement.
- Ongoing support from S2S Staff.
- The chance to be part of a supportive and engaged S2S community.
- The opportunity to make a meaningful impact on the student experience by training future Mentors.

Key Responsibilities

- Deliver the S2S Mentor Training package alongside a co-trainer.
- Facilitate group discussions and activities during sessions.
- Record training attendance for each session.
- Answer participants' questions.
- Ensure the training room is left tidy and that all training pack materials are filed appropriately.
- Communicate any issues, participant concerns, or incidents to S2S Staff promptly.
