Role Description

An S2S Mentor is a Trinity student who volunteers to provide guidance and support to a group of incoming undergraduate 1st years. As a Mentor, you will be one of the first students to welcome them to campus and help them feel that they belong.



Requirements

- Attend a 4hr in-person training.
- Complete a Blackboard module over the summer.
- Be available for an orientation session in September during Freshers' Week.
- Contribute 1-3hrs per week during the academic year.
- Apply for Garda vetting clearance (subject to group membership).
- Attend meetings with Head Mentors.
- Liaise with S2S staff.
- Log all your activity on our volunteer portal.

Benefits

- Full training (one in-person 4hr training and one online module).
- Mentor buddy to work with.
- Excellent experience in leadership, teamwork, and active listening.
- References based on logged activity and involvement.
- Year-round support from Head Mentors, Committee, and Staff.
- Strong social network and community.
- The chance to make a difference in a student's transition to Trinity.

Key Responsibilities

As an S2S Mentor you play a crucial role at orientation, as well as offering guidance and support to mentees throughout the academic year.

During Orientation:

- Run an Icebreaker session
- Give a guided campus tour
- Have a Q&A session

- Send weekly emails to mentees
- Organise 5 group meet-ups per term
- Log activity on Odyssey portal
