

Mentor Trainer Role Description



What is a Mentor Trainer?

An S2S Mentor Trainer is a paid student who delivers Mentor training alongside another Trainer to the new Mentors for the next academic year. Mentor Trainers will have been a Mentor previously and can use their experience in the training room to help provide a more accurate expectation to the new Mentors.

What is involved?



S2S will be running 40 4-hour training sessions between February and May. As a trainer you will:

- Deliver the S2S training package
- Facilitate group work within training session
- Take training attendance
- Answer any questions students might have
- Collect and return training packs to S2S office

What do you get?



You will receive:

- Full training (one in person 3hour training session)
- Payment of €14 per hour
- Excellent experience in leadership, team work and facilitation
- Guaranteed references based on logged activity and involvement
- Support from S2S Staff
- A fellow trainer to co-deliver each session with you

What is expected?



You will be expected to:

- Attend a 15 minute interview
- Attend one in-person training session (3 Hours)
- Have a valid PPS number and work permit where applicable
- Deliver at least 1 training session per week/fortnight from Feb-May
- To have trained and engaged as a Mentor for at least 1 year
- Respond to and liaise with S2S staff
