What is a degree pathway?

- The pathway that you choose this year is your final Degree Pathway.
- This pathway will determine how your 60 ECTS will be distributed between your subject(s) and possibly Open Modules and Trinity Electives in both Year 3 and Year 4.
- It is not possible to change your degree pathway between Year 3 and Year 4.
- You will be invited to participate in Degree Pathway Selection from:
 - **11 to 25 March 2026**



Reflect

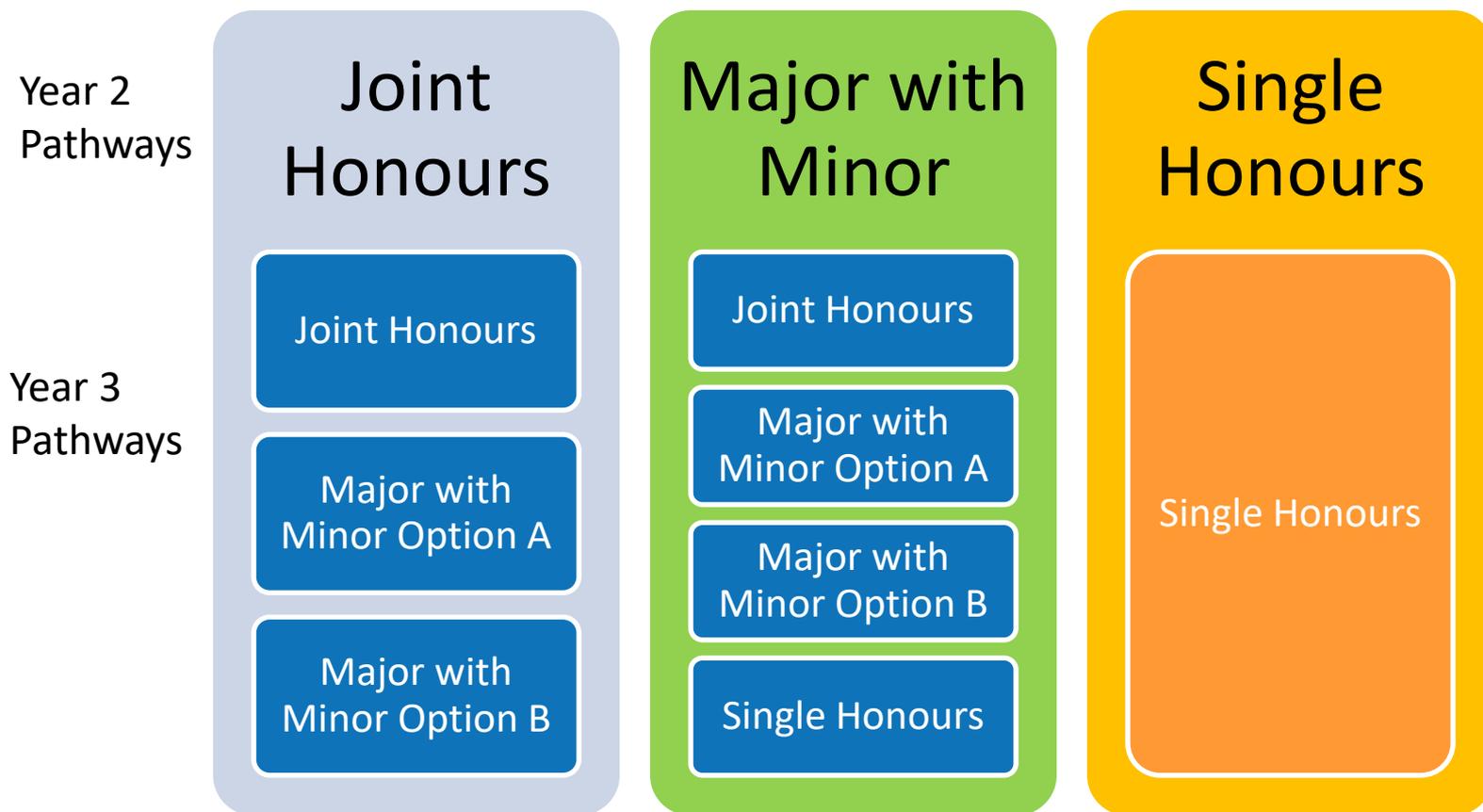
- Ask yourself:
 - What are you enjoying?
 - Where are your academic strengths?
 - Are you interested in things outside of your core subjects? Or would you like to stay focused on your core?
 - Do I want to go on outbound exchange in third year? Where do I want to go?
 - What subject do I want to do my Capstone, i.e. final year project/thesis in?
 - Beyond graduation – postgraduate studies? Career?

Research

- Look at:
 - Handbooks, subject web pages, module and pre-requisite information
 - TJH Pathways, Open Module, Trinity Elective, & Outbound Mobility websites
- Ask others:
 - S2S Mentors & upper year classmates – lived experience
 - Year co-ordinators or heads of departments
 - College Tutor
 - disAbility Service – especially important if thinking of going on exchange!
 - UCAO Team

What degree pathways are available to me?

- The degree pathways available to you for your Sophister years depend on your pathway in Year 2.
- Some subjects have limited pathways. If you were on this pathway in Year 2 – then these are the pathways open to you.....

Joint Honours Pathway



Pros

Study both subjects equally in Year 3 (30 ECTS each) & Year 4 (20 ECTS)

You can pick which subject your Capstone (20 ECTS) is in*



Cons

Some subjects may provide a smaller selection of core modules on this pathway

* Capstone module prerequisites may apply

Major/Minor Pathway Option A



Pros

Study both subjects only in Year 3
(Major 40 ECTS, Minor 20 ECTS)

Study both subjects in Year 4 (20
ECTS each)

Capstone in Major Subject only (20
ECTS) *

Cons

Study both subjects in Year 4

Some subjects may provide a
smaller selection of core modules
on the minor pathway



* Capstone module prerequisites may apply

Major/Minor Pathway Option B



Pros

Study both subjects only in Year 3
(30 ECTS each)

Finish study of Minor Subject in Year 3
3 – 60 ECTS in Major only in Year 4

Capstone in Major Subject only (20 ECTS) *

Cons

Minor subject finishes in Year 3

Some subjects may provide smaller selection of core modules on this pathway

Single Honour Pathway



Pros

One core subject only

In order to access this degree pathway you must have completed 40 ECTS in SH subject in the Year 2 ie Majored in it

Take Open Modules/Trinity Electives or Subject 2 in Year 3 (10 ECTS)

Capstone (20 ECTS) & final year modules (40 ECTS) are in SH subject only



Cons

Not available to all subjects/combinations

Once you select this you cannot add an additional subject or your second subject

Take Open Modules/Trinity Electives or Subject 2 in Year 3 (10 ECTS)

Considerations

- The following subjects have additional [pathway restrictions and/or requirements](#) for students entering the Junior Sophister year in 2026/27. Please consult with your department to ensure you are aware of how this might apply to you.
 - Business
 - Classical Languages (Greek and Latin)
 - Computer Science
 - Economics
 - Law
 - Linguistics
 - Mathematics
 - Modern Languages
 - Social Policy
 - Sociology
- **Capstone** – please be aware that some pre-requisite module requirements may exist. Further information is available here: <https://www.tcd.ie/tjh/currentstudents/year4/capstone/>

Whatever pathway you take, your degree will be calculated based on modules completed as follows:
Year 3 – 30%, Year 4 70%



Pathways and their impact on Erasmus and Study Abroad

- You are expected to study both Subjects (except if on Single Honours pathway) abroad
- You have to study both subjects as per your ECTS requirements if you are on Joint Honours or Major Minor Option A/B pathway
- Not all host universities can accommodate all pathways and this should be part of your consideration
- Your Learning Agreement must be approved by both of your co-ordinators (if applicable) and this office (UCAO) before you go on exchange
- If you cannot fulfil the pathway requirements abroad you may have to return to Trinity within the first 4 weeks of the applicable term and email tjh.erasmus-studyabroad@tcd.ie so we can investigate any potential solutions available.



Pathways and their impact on Erasmus and Study Abroad

- You are expected to take the recommended amount of ECTS per pathway
- Front-loading is an exception and permission must be given by both Subjects and our office
- Single Honours pathway – you do not take Open Modules/TE/Subject 2 while abroad
