## YEAR 3

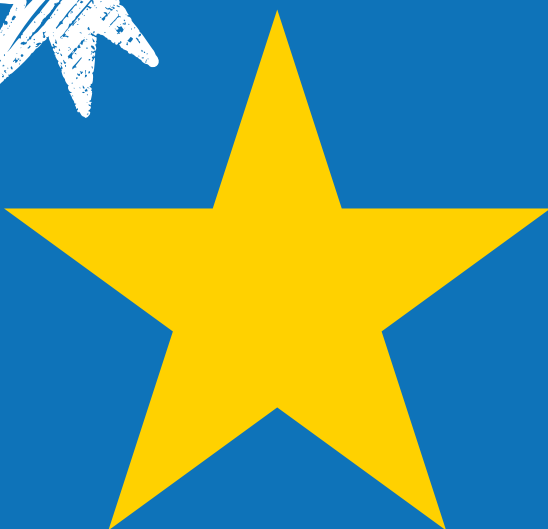
You will start to be appointed to the Head Ambassador role where appropriate and take on the peer support and public speaking roles if/when you are comfortable
