



CLINICAL AND NON-CLINICAL LOG

The Clinical and Non Clinical Log is a supporting document for the Student Pathway or Risk of Failure Form. This log may be used to provide a brief record of any patient episode or non-clinical incident when an educator has a concern regarding a student's performance. These may include repeated safety or professional issues. The 'Clinical and Non-Clinical Log' is also a record that feedback was provided to the student. Students can be asked to sign the form to confirm feedback was provided by the educator or tutor. The Discipline of Physiotherapy should be informed if any serious safety or professional issues arise. Part 2 of the CAF should be used to issue a *warning* relating to any specific safety or professional issue.
