Pre-Master's Pathway Programme (PMPP)

Is the PMPP for me?

Yes, if you are a student with a conditional offer for postgraduate study at Trinity College Dublin and an overall IELTS score of 6.0.

Passing the PMPP will enable you to fulfil Trinity's English language requirement.

What will I learn?

The PMPP is an intensive course that will help you to learn and develop the academic English skills you need for entry into postgraduate study at Trinity.

Entry requirements

IELTS 6.0 overall score, with no individual band less than 5.5 (or equivalent).

Schedule and fees

- ▶ Duration: 10 weeks – 25 May to 31 July 2020
- ▶ Classes: 20 hours per week (4 hours per day)
- ▶ Tuition fee: €3,450

Entry requirements

IELTS 6.5 overall score, with no individual band less than 6.0 (or equivalent).

Schedule and fees

- ▶ Duration: 4 weeks – 4 August to 28 August 2020
- ▶ Classes: 20 hours per week (4 hours per day)
- ▶ Tuition fee: €1,350

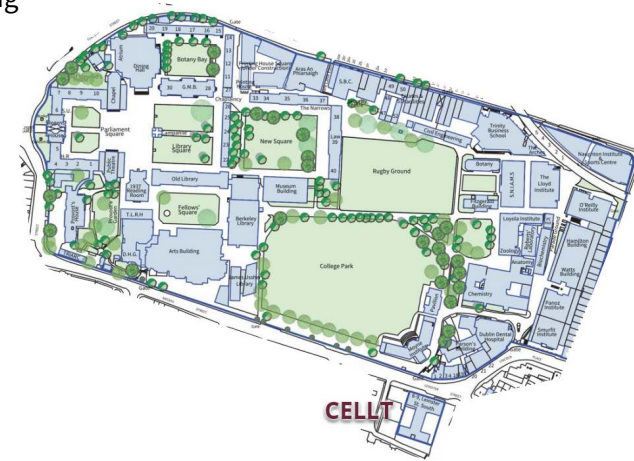
