
What are pathways?

And when will you select them?

- Pathways allow you to have some *flexibility* about you programme of study and your exit degree
- Depending on your pathway you have options to take *Designed Open Modules* and *Trinity Electives*, which are modules from disciplines outside your core subjects.
- You make your pathway choice after completion of your Junior Fresh year
- Pathway choice for SF does not yet commit you to a specific exit degree (exception: Single Honors pathway)

BESS and PPES are Common Architecture Programmes

Which pathways are available to you?



- Single Honors
 - 40 credits in chosen Subject, 10 credits of *Designated Open Modules* and 10 credits of *Trinity Electives*
- Major with Minor40 credits in S1 and 20 credits in S2
- Joint Honors
 20 credits in S1, 20 credits in S2, 10 credits of *Designated Open Modules*,
 10 credits in *Trinity Electives*
- Three Subjects/Triple Strand
 20 credits in S1, 20 credits in S2, 20 credits in S3


Which pathways to choose?

Things to consider

- Academic decision up to you! You may consult academic staff in your subjects and department websites for information
- Do you want to take Designated Open Modules and Trinity Electives?
- Remember: You will still have options as to your degree pathway at the end of Senior Fresh – with exception of Single Honors Pathway
- For a Single Honors degree you need to take 40 ECTS in the subject in Senior Fresh (either through Single Honors or Major/Minor pathway)

Looking ahead

Choices for Junior Sophister Years (your third year) and fourth year study




KEY: S1 - Subject 1 S2 - Subject 2 OM - Open Modules | TE - Trinity Electives | JS - Junior Sophister | SS - Senior Sophister

You choose your **final degree pathway** after finishing your Senior Fresh year:

- Single Honors (SH or MM in SF)
 50 credits in Subject + 10 Designated
 OM
- Major with Minor (MM, JH, TS in SF)
 40 S1 and 20 S2 or
 30 S1 and 30 S2
- Joint Honors (MM, JH, TS in SF)
 30 S1 and 30 S2

Summary



Anything else you should keep in mind

- If you are considering taking Foundation Scholarship Examinations in your SF year, the pathway you choose will impact the structure of your examinations.
- The degree pathway you choose for your Junior Sophister year will affect the structure of any Erasmus or Study Abroad Exchange.
- Students who may want to complete a final year capstone project in Sociology should contact the department to ensure they take prerequisite modules that are taught in SF year.
