



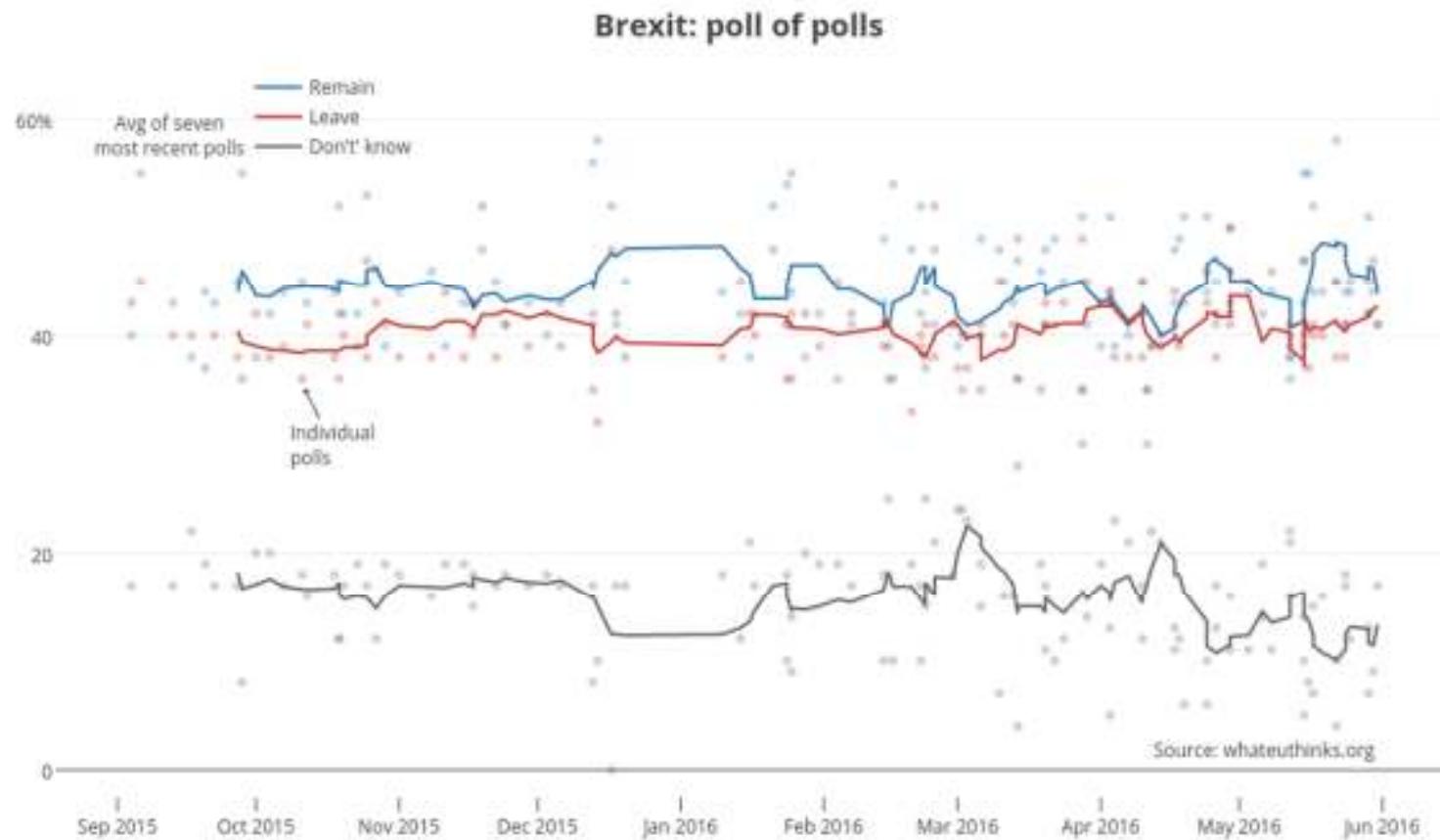

## The betting markets give Remain a 72 per cent chance of winning

The margin was wider in late May, when several public figures were highlighting the economic case for staying in the EU, but has since narrowed before appearing to stabilise around the 70-30 mark

Implied probability of getting more seats than any other party, from average UK odds

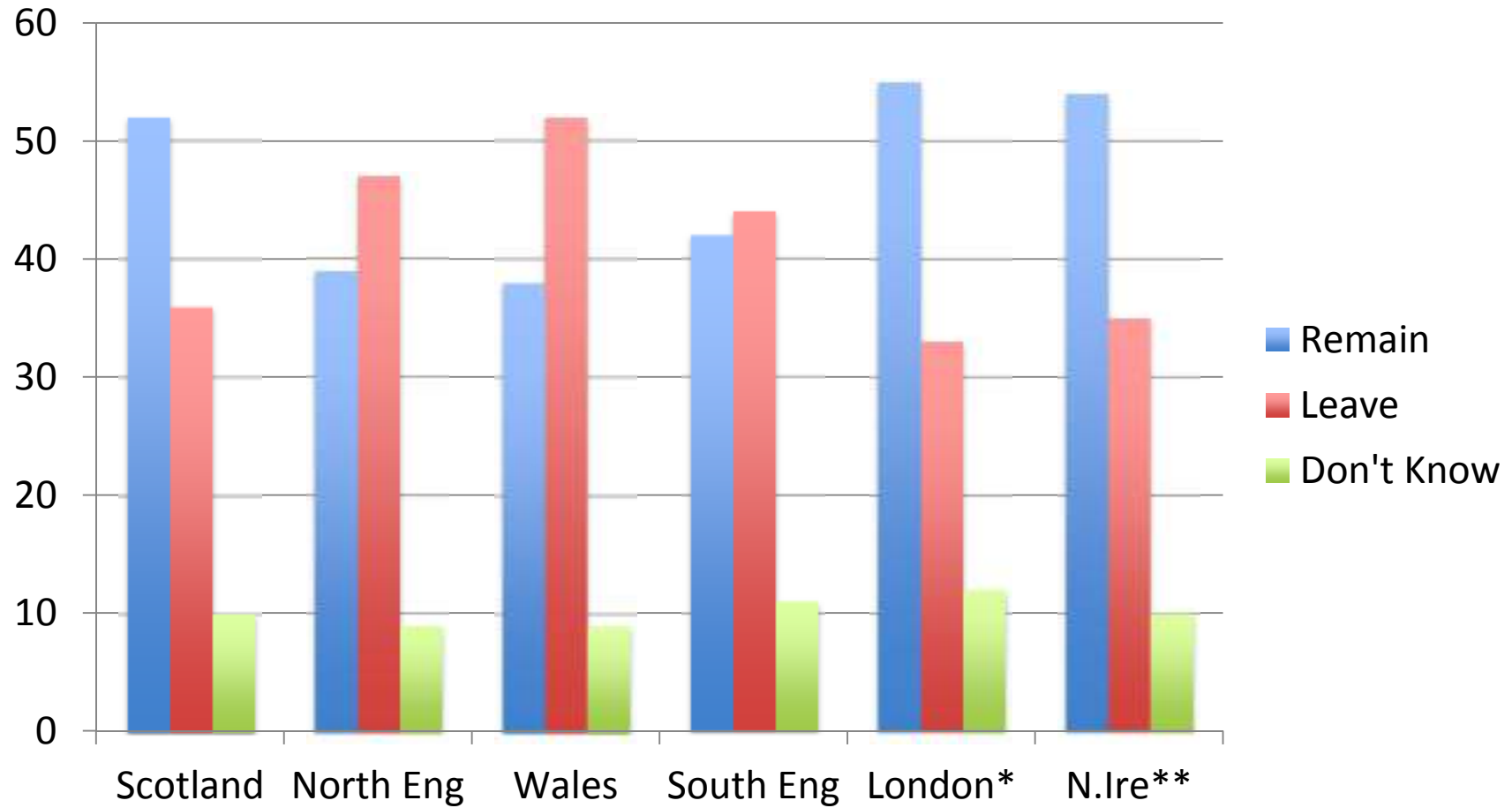

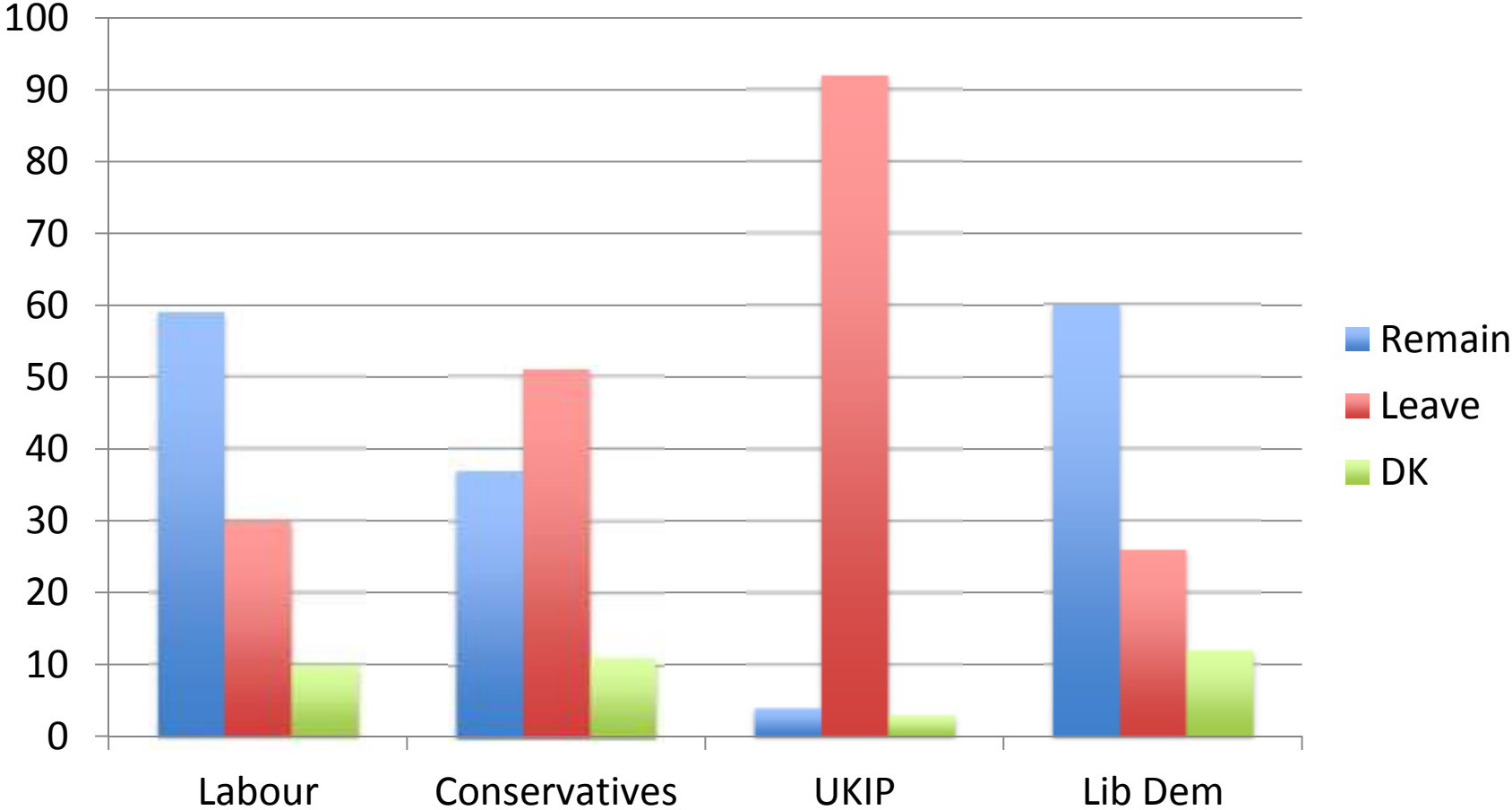

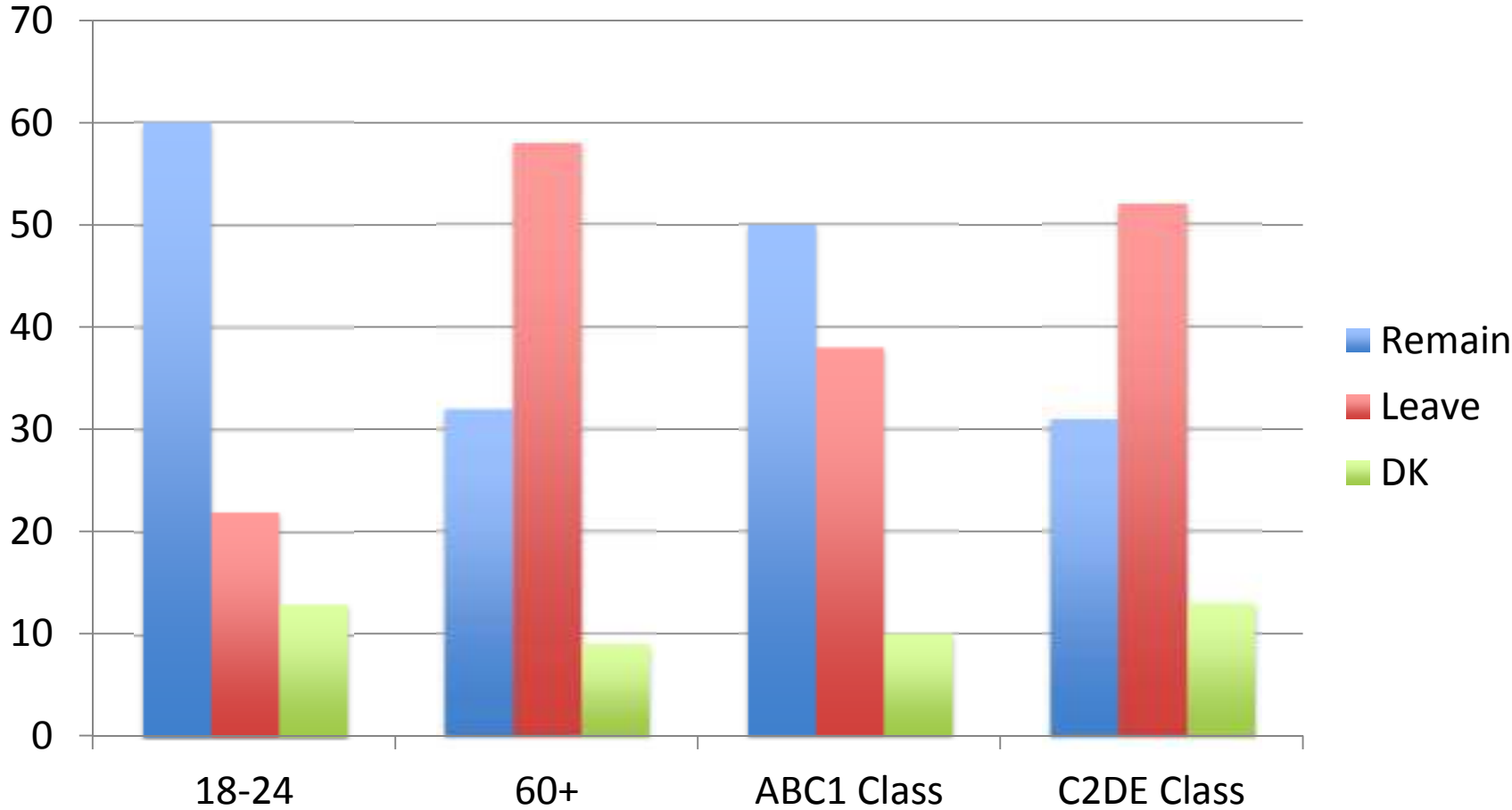
