Structure of the Academic Year

Term 2 (Hilary Term, HT)

Teaching Starts: 1st February

Study Week: 14th March

» No lectures and tutorials during this week

Teaching ends: 23rd April

Revision week: 3rd May

Assessment starts: 10th May

What is the right module load?

One Term Students (Michaelmas Term or Hilary Term)	Between 25 and 30 ECTS
Full Year Students	Between 50 and 60 ECTS

- Take about 80% 100% of a Trinity student's module load (but meet the requirements of your home university)
 - Please be advised that you will only be enrolled on modules amounting to 30 ECTS for each Semester.
- You cannot take modules that clash on the timetable
- The timetable for modules is on your mytcd.ie portal

ECTS Credits at Trinity

Year	1 Term
2nd Year (Senior Fresh, SF)	5 credits
3rd Year (Junior Sophister, JS)	5 credits
4th Year (Senior Sophister, SS)**	7.5/10 credits***

^{**} The Department of Political Science does not accept Visiting and Erasmus students in SS (4th year) modules

^{***} Exchange students do an additional assignment

Choosing and Registering for modules

- List of available modules in:
 - Trinity Business School: <u>here</u>
 - School of Social Science and Philosophy: <u>here</u>
 - Some modules have quotas: see website
 - Be aware that to enrol in any module they must satisfy the prerequisites as listed, i.e. you should have studied a similar module to the prerequisite in your home institution.
- Submit your modules choice to Academic Registry. Ensure module codes are correct. If there are clashes you will not be able to register.
- Coordinators will check your prerequisites and confirm to Academic Registry your acceptance to the modules.
 - If some of the selected modules have pre-requisites, please provide the necessary proofs to your coordinator.
