# Structure of the Academic Year

---

## – Term 1 (Michaelmas Term, MT)

- Teaching starts: 28<sup>th</sup> September (on 5<sup>th</sup> October for 1<sup>st</sup> year modules)
  - Study Week: 9<sup>th</sup> November (no study week for 1<sup>st</sup> year modules)
    - » No lectures and tutorials during this week
- Teaching ends: 18<sup>th</sup> December
- Revision week: 4<sup>th</sup> January
- Assessment starts: 11<sup>th</sup> January

# Structure of the Academic Year

---

- **Term 2 (Hilary Term, HT)**
  - Teaching Starts: 1<sup>st</sup> February
    - Study Week: 14<sup>th</sup> March
      - » No lectures and tutorials during this week
  - Teaching ends: 23<sup>rd</sup> April
  - Revision week: 3<sup>rd</sup> May
  - Assessment starts: 10<sup>th</sup> May

# What is the right module load?

<b>One Term Students (Michaelmas Term or Hilary Term)</b>	<b>Between 25 and 30 ECTS</b>
<b>Full Year Students</b>	<b>Between 50 and 60 ECTS</b>

- Take about 80% - 100% of a Trinity student's module load (but meet the requirements of your home university)
  - Please be advised that you will only be enrolled on modules amounting to 30 ECTS for each Semester.
- You cannot take modules that clash on the timetable
- The timetable for modules is on your mytcd.ie portal

# ECTS Credits at Trinity

Year	1 Term	Full Year
2nd Year (Senior Fresh, SF)	5 credits	10 credits
3rd Year (Junior Sophister, JS)	5 credits	10 credits
4th Year (Senior Sophister, SS)**	7.5/10 credits***	10/15

\*\* The Department of Political Science does not accept Visiting and Erasmus students in SS (4<sup>th</sup> year) modules

\*\*\* Exchange students do an additional assignment

    - Be aware that to enrol in any module they must satisfy the prerequisites as listed, i.e. you should have studied a similar module to the prerequisite in your home institution.
- Submit your modules choice to Academic Registry. Ensure module codes are correct. If there are clashes you will not be able to register.
- Coordinators will check your prerequisites and confirm to Academic Registry your acceptance to the modules.
  - If some of the selected modules have pre-requisites, please provide the necessary proofs to your coordinator.
