

HEALTH SCREENING FEES 2026/27

The Health Screening fee is **€330** and will appear as a separate charge on the student fee statement.

It should be paid via **my.tcd.ie** portal.

This fee should be paid during the designated payment period advised by Academic Registry and Student Finance.

Students experiencing financial difficulty may be eligible to pay this fee by instalments. This will be facilitated through Student Finance, subject to the University's standard payment plan procedures.

Students may be eligible for partial refunds where certain Health screening services are deemed unnecessary following review by College Health.

What services does this Health Screening Fee cover?

- Blood tests to check for Hepatitis B, Hepatitis C, HIV and Varicella Zoster (Chicken Pox) immune status.
- Quantiferon (IGRA) blood test (TB screening)
- Course of Hep B vaccination (3 doses)
- Provision of regular updates to school regarding student's Health screening status.
- Provision of Immunity Declaration Certificate and Occupational Health File once process completed.

What is not included in the €330 (HSC)?

- Any Varicella vaccines required (if your health screening blood test shows that you are not varicella immune)
- Additional Hepatitis B vaccines required above the standard Hepatitis B course of 3 doses.
