

Dear Student Nurse/Midwife,

Welcome to the School of Nursing & Midwifery at Trinity College. We are delighted that you have been offered a place on the Bachelor in Science (Nursing/Midwifery/General and Children's Nursing) course.

The course will begin 19<sup>th</sup> September 2022 as per your course timetable.

Shortly after CAO reply date you will receive a message in your in-tray via Student Information System (SITS) access via my.tcd.ie where you will be asked to select your preferred training hospital/service for the Bachelor in Science Nursing/Midwifery course.

## Please note for your information:

## 1. Garda Vetting

Students on courses with clinical or other professional placements are required to undergo Garda vetting procedures prior to commencing placements. If, as a result of the outcome of the Garda vetting procedures, a student is deemed unsuitable to attend clinical or other professional placement, he/she may be required to withdraw from his/her course.

Students who have resided outside Ireland for a consecutive period of 6 months or more will be required to provide police clearance documentation from the country in which they resided at the time of registration.

Students offered a place in Nursing/Midwifery in Trinity will be informed as appropriate when Garda vetting forms have been uploaded on the TCD website for completion (as part of the student orientation information). These completed forms <u>must</u> be returned to the Academic Registry.

NB It is <u>imperative</u> students engage with all aspects of the garda vetting process at the earliest point as directed by Academic Registry. <u>Any</u> delays will result in students not being permitted to commence clinical placements.

## 2. Registration

All students must be registered prior to commencing clinical. Therefore it is imperative students engage in the registration process at the earliest possible point.
