IF YOU NEED TO TALK...

POSTGRADUATE BORROWING

USING THE LIBRARY

Higher Degree (Research/Taught Masters/PhD) May borrow up to 50 books at any one time which can include items available for lending from the Open Access and Stacks collections

•General lending (books with the pre-fixes: LEN, S-LEN, SJ) – up to 10

•Legal deposit (includes most open access + storage books) – up to 50

•Short loan* (i.e. high demand books) – up to 50

•General lending can be borrowed for 12 weeks and renewed 5 times

•Legal deposit materials can be borrowed for 3 months and renewed once for a further 3 months.

•Short loan collections can be borrowed for up to 5 hours for consultation within the library

Click and Collect requests and reservations

- Click and Collect requests: 20
- Inter-Library Loan requests: 20
- You may place a reservation to place yourself next in line for a book currently on loan, but this will not currently shorten the due date of an item



BOOK a slot to enter the Library - this is mandatory

SEARCH for books from your reading list or on your topic using the Library's catalogue, <u>Stella Search</u>

INSTALL <u>Lean Library</u> to find the full text of articles via Google or Google Scholar

BORROW up to 50 books at a time

REQUEST books from storage using our Click and Collect service in <u>Stella Search</u>

USE the Self-Service Kiosks to borrow or return books

PRINT/COPY/SCAN on any printer (service managed by <u>Datapac</u>). ID code = your student number; PIN e-mailed when you register with TCD

SIGN UP to any of our online training sessions -Library HITS - and brush up on your research skills

CONTACT your <u>Subject Librarian</u> for expert searching advice
