

Broad Curriculum FAQs for Visiting & Erasmus Students

I'm a Visiting/Erasmus student, can I apply for Broad Curriculum modules?

Yes, so long as you've checked you're eligible to take your chosen modules on the [2018/2019 Credit Regulation guidelines](#).

How do I register for Broad Curriculum Modules?

You can apply via an online [Google application form](#).

When can I apply for the Broad Curriculum modules?

You can apply for Broad Curriculum modules as soon as you're fully registered at TCD. More information on Orientation can be found [here](#).

Do I need to fill in all four preferences?

It is vital that all fields, including the ones for all additional four preferences are completed. This allows us to move down your list of preferences if there is a timetable clash on your first and subsequent preferences.

What is the 'Additional modules' options for?

Additional modules section allows the student to enter modules should they be required to, or wish to take a second module.

When will I know if I've been enrolled on a BC module?

You will be notified by email. The BC module that you have been enrolled in will also be visible in your student portal mytcd.ie.

Can I enter a Language module on the Cross Faculty application?

Unfortunately no, Language modules are administered by the [Centre for Language and Communication Studies \(CLCS\)](#). Broad Curriculum Cross Faculty modules are administered by Academic Registry.

What happens if my selected BC modules have a timetable clash with my course modules?

You will be asked to choose alternative modules and resubmit the online form.

Can I change my mind regarding my choice(s) of module?

If you have changed your mind, you can re-submit a new online form with your new choices.
