### Information for Non EU applicants presenting A Level

#### General Admission Requirements for all courses:

To be considered for admission to the University you must:

- Present six subjects at grade C or above on IGCSE/ GCSE or Advanced Subsidiary GCE (AS) papers. Two of these subjects must be at grade C or above on Advanced GCE (A-Level) papers.

The six subjects above must include:

- A pass in English

AND

- A pass in mathematics and a pass in a language other than English

OR

- a pass in Latin and a pass in a subject other than a language

Notes:

1. A pass means grade C or above on IGCSE/GCSE or Advanced Subsidiary GCE (AS) papers.
2. Students may combine grades achieved in different sittings of their Advanced GCE (A-Level) examinations for the purpose of satisfying minimum entry and/or course requirements.

English requirement: GCSE: a grade C or better in English Language.
