Revised A-Level Scoring Scheme

A revised scoring scheme will be implemented for A-Level examination results in 2019. Points are weighted in favour of the first three A-Levels, with additional points awarded for a fourth A Level or for a fourth AS Level subject.

New Leaving Certificate Subjects from 2020

- Computer Science will be accepted as one of the subjects satisfying minimum entry requirements and for scoring purposes.
- It will also be accepted as one of the subjects satisfying the specific course requirements for the following courses: TR060 Biological and Biomedical Sciences; TR061 Chemical Sciences; TR062 Geography and Geoscience; TR063 Physical Sciences and TR072 Pharmacy.
- Physical Education will be accepted as one of the subjects satisfying minimum entry requirements and for scoring purposes.
