

Students can apply to any Coimbra partners that provide appropriate modules that match with what they study here in Trinity & have the appropriate permission from their Academic Coordinator.

Students are expected to undertake their own research into these universities to gather information needed (what languages they use to teach, what disciplines are offered etc.)

Application is managed centrally by Global and the Erasmus grant paperwork by Academic Registry.

Students should write to **global.mobility@tcd.ie** to express an interest.

Applications open Oct 16th and will close on Nov 17th

Applying to Coimbra Partners

The application is straightforward and involves ranking your three top choices and then justifying your choices.

Students are assessed based on their overall results from their first year of studies as well as their motivations.

A panel reviews the applications and decides on the offers to make to students when there is competition for the same places.

Coimbra exchanges take place within the Erasmus framework and eligible for Erasmus grant while on a Coimbra Group exchange.

Participating in ELAN Exchange

May participate in an exchange with any ELAN university under Erasmus (note Bristol)

Exchanges can be for one term or the whole year in the same institution or for two terms in two different institutions.

To qualify for an ELAN exchange, you must have an overall II/1 grade from your first year of study at TCD.

Several of the partner universities teach modules through the medium of English. These are: Charles University Prague, Utrecht University College, University of Bristol, University of Graz, University of Siena and Uppsala University. For the other partners, some knowledge of the local language is advisable.
