The gentlemen living in Dromroe pooled their resources and efforts to take advantage of the good weather and painted the decking, railings and outdoor furniture.



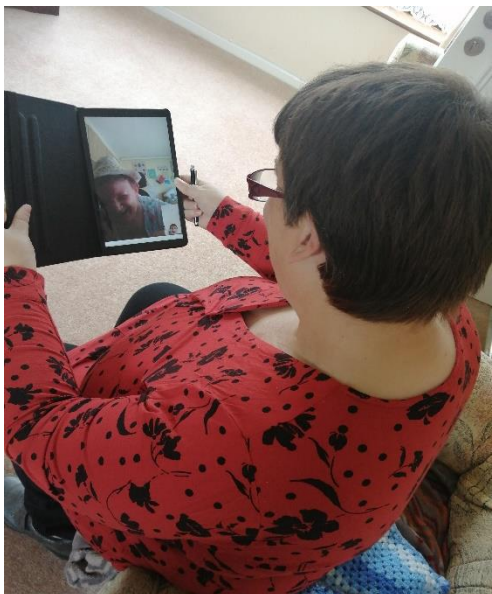
Playing Hop scotch in Lantern Lodge

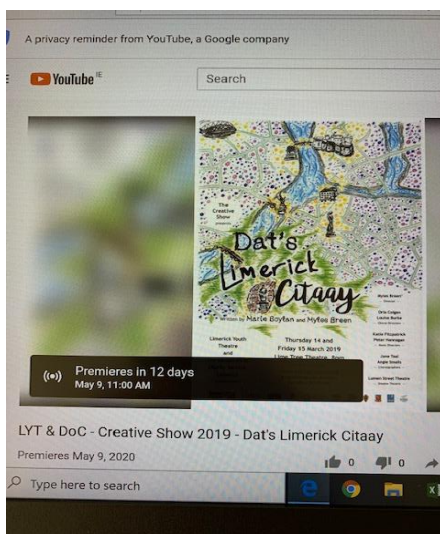


Garden Meditation in The Meadows.
