Mortality rates in the General Irish population compared to those with intellectual disability from 2003 – 2012

Mortality higher in women across age groups. Average age of death 19.07 years earlier than for the general population.

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

Longitudinal study collecting data every 3 years which we refer to as a wave

First nationally-representative longitudinal study on ageing with an intellectual disability comparable to the general population




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




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
