Every few days we check our plants and water them.


Mark planted some tomato seeds and now calls himself the 'Tomato Man' !

We have played some games together our favourite is Jenga!






We also had a 'Movie Night' in Landscape.

John was the 'Ticket Man' he collected all the movie tickets. We all sat down and watched a movie together.


Here is Alice joining her peers for the movie night.

Here is Mark, Paul and Elizabeth watching their movie!






Here are some lovely pictures of John, Paul and Elizabeth out for walks and enjoying a Picnic!
