

How to Find Information on Open Modules:

This short guide has been compiled to assist students looking for information regarding module outlines and assessment for Open Modules. The information can usually be found in the following areas online:

- 1. The my.tcd.ie portal
- 2. School and departmental websites
 - a. Module directory
 - b. Course handbooks
 - c. Local access areas on the departmental website


Students accessing information using my.tcd.ie portal.

In the my.tcd.ie portal, students should have access to 'Course & Modules' tab. In here you can input the module code. You should be able to view information regarding assessment and course outlines here. The screenshot below highlights the areas where you can find the tab and the module descriptive details.

How to find module details

Descriptions for modules can be accessed from my.tcd.ie by clicking on the plus symbol and browsing to "Courses & Modules". Then click on the "View Module Descriptive Details" link.

Then enter the code of the module and click the "view modules button".



2. School and Departmental websites.

If you are unable to view the information regarding assessment and course outlines via my.tcd.ie, School and Departmental web pages can be another source to find the information you need.
