Trinity Joint Honours Programmes – Major with Minor Pathways in Year 2

All students on Trinity Joint Honours programmes will take 4 examinations, however the structure of examinations will depend upon the pathway chosen prior to the start of Senior Freshman year.

The information in this document pertains to students who are on the ‘Major with Minor’ pathway – this means you are taking 40 credits in one subject (the Major subject) and 20 credits in the other subject (the Minor subject).

Students on the Major with Minor pathway are able to choose between the two structures below for their Foundation Scholarship Examinations:
