



## **Freiraum: Creative Arts Programme**

### **Description:**

This TY programme focuses on the expressions and ideas of Creative Arts in Dublin city today. Each session is hosted by our cultural arts partners and exposes our TY students to each institutes' programmes through interactive sessions. The programme plans to encourage a sense of creative expression amongst its participants and also deepen their cultural capital by exposing students to new subjects available to them at third-level.

These sessions provide opportunities for students to explore topics of art, culture, literature and politics through an emphasis on the challenges placed upon access to Creative Arts spaces today.

### **Duration:**

This is a 1 week course with 4-5 sessions per day. The sessions will start at 9:30 am and finish at 1:30 pm, approx. Each session will last 1 hour. Students will participate in these sessions via an online platform.

### **Commitment from Schools:**

In order to participate in the programme, schools would need to commit to the following;

- A linked teacher to liaise with the programme facilitator
- A 1-week block within the TY timetable for participants
- A minimum of 4 students to participate
- As the programme is currently facilitated online, students would need access to devices
