



Freiraum: European Languages and Cultures Programme

Description:

This TY programme focuses on the expressions and ideas of freedom in Europe today. Each session is hosted by our European Union National Institutes of Culture (EUNIC) and exposes our TY students to each institutes' art, literature, food and culture through interactive cultural sessions, language lessons, library tours and film screenings. The programme plans to encourage a sense of creative expression amongst its participants and also deepen their cultural capital by exposing students to new subjects available to them at third-level.

These sessions provide opportunities for students to explore topics of art, culture, literature and politics through an emphasis on the challenges placed upon freedom (Brexit, immigration and the climate crisis) in Europe today.

Duration:

This is a 1 week course with 4-5 sessions per day. The sessions will start at 9:30 am and finish at 1:30 pm, approx. Each session will last 1 hour. Students will participate in these sessions via an online platform.

Commitment from Schools:

In order to participate in the programme, schools would need to commit to the following;

- A linked teacher to liaise with the programme facilitator
- A 1-week block within the TY timetable for participants
- A minimum of 4 students to participate
- As the programme is currently facilitated online, students would need access to devices
